I enclose a copy of your employees' "Requirement to Pay" the sum of \$120,623.66 which has been sent on November 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2005 to my employer, ReMax 2000 Realty (Panorama), and which I have only received on November 21<sup>st</sup>, 2005.

As you know, I have been corresponding personally, and through my Chartered Accountant, Loewen and Stronach, of Vancouver, with your office ("The Taxman") for over ten years to resolve my \$200,000 business and investment losses in business, dating back to 1990-92. Over the years, I have received numerous assessments, re-assessments and hundreds of letters that, quite frankly, I do **not** understand due to the language used and the total lack of CCRA's understanding on my plight as a taxpayer.

I ask the question: How does the Taxman have the right (without the Judgement of a Court of Law) to issue a "Requirement to Pay", serve it on an employer, and the employer (out of fear of reprisal) pays over the money demanded by the taxman?

To me, that is theft by coercion and intimidation, and **you**, in this country, and the I.R.S. in the U.S.A., have been getting away with this criminal activity for a century.

Just like the CNR derailing cars up and down the 'Sea to Sky' Highway in Beautiful British Columbia, I am beginning a campaign today to derail you and your bureaucrats (G. I hereby demand:

- (1) an apology from you and G. Sigmund for two years of ignoring my attempt to resolve my alleged income tax liability; and

- (2) demand that you issue immediately (before December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2005) a withdrawal of the “Requirement to Pay” sent to my employer on November 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2005 (copy enclosed).

If you fail to take immediate action, I will:

- (1) immediately take steps to activate the website that I have secured three years ago: [www.antitaxcrusader.com](http://www.antitaxcrusader.com), and post all my correspondence to and from the taxman, my biography dating back to 1960’s, and documents and newspapers clipping about the Taxman that I have been storing for years.
- (2) issue the enclosed “News Release” in this year’s Christmas Season, so that Canadians once again can become acquainted with Captain Canada, now humbly known as Mr.B.C.
- (3) begin planning a cross Canada Crusade from Victoria, B.C. to Cape Spear (St. John), Newfoundland to co-incide with the next Federal Election in January, 2006, to publicize your atrocities against myself and other Canadians who are among my members.

It was forty-two years ago today, November 23, 1963, that one of my heros died in Dallas, Texas, namely **John F. Kennedy**, President of the United States of America. He died as he was about to expose the corruption in the banking system and multinational corporations throughout the world. In his book, “Profiles in Courage”, he had a quote that I have lived by as a lawyer, as a crusader, and as a person all my life:

*“Never negotiate out of fear,  
but never fear to negotiate”.*

Do I make myself clear!! If the taxman wants to fight, I have rested for 20 years, and I am ready once again to ‘stand up and be counted’.
